CALL TO ORDER

Chairman Loyd called the Regular Meeting to order at 8:29 a.m.

APPROVAL OF MINUTES

Director Lake moved to approve the minutes of January 21, 2020.

Director Humphrey seconded the motion. All present were in favor.

FINANCIAL REPORT AND APPROVAL

Treasurer Parker reported that the dashboard had been redesigned to reflect the '1,2' information for purposes of tying numbers together. Director Webking complimented Jeanene on the updated information, confirming review of both the December and the January information and the clarity of the reported numbers.

Director Webking moved to approve the five items as follows: (1) Approval Report Unpaid over \$5000 excluding recurring for the period 01.21.20 – 02.17.20 for \$38,194.43; (2) the Paid Invoice Report for the period 01.21.20 – 02.17.20 for \$95,838.28; (3) the Payroll Report for the period 12.23.19 – 01.05.20 for \$13,419.45, (4) the Payroll Report for the period 01.06.20 – 01.19.20 for \$13,959.98; and (5) the Wells Fargo Credit Card Statement in the amount of \$1,170.02.

Director Lake seconded the motion. All present were in favor.

WASTEWATER TREATMENT PLANT REPORT

Superintendent Mummert noted that the Ketchum Solid Waste Plant is, in fact, still working well – even through the recent Presidents Day weekend. Superintendent Mummert noted that the Weyakin neighborhood had requested that the KSTP review its reUse water nitrogen and phosphorous levels, as the homeowners association is experiencing increased algae levels in its water features & ponds, and believes that the reUse water may be contributing to such growth. KSTP currently meets all State and Federal requirements for reUse water, its safety and viability. The Elkhorn Golf Course, also a major consumer of reUse water, is pleased with the water as it currently receives it, and does not prefer adjustment to the chemical makeup. KSTP has taken this request under consideration. Interestingly, on the heels of last months' conversation about a local brewery and waste-mash impacts - there is a treatment plant in Montana which is using spent mash to clear wastewater of nitrogen.

Ketchum plant operations are good, the facility is fully staffed.

ANNUAL AUDIT – ENGAGEMENT LETTER

Director Webking spoke to the Eide Bailly CPA firm understanding of services he had received & executed, related to the annual audit of the books for fiscal year ending November 30, 2019. Explanation that the document is not a contract in the classical sense (having no time frame and being terminated at any time), and the document sets out what both parties are responsible for, including GAAP parameters, related to retaining this firm for the audit year end 11.30.19. Chairman Loyd expressed query in regard to the document's execution, and general conversation around such signatory process at Board level occurred. Attorney Robertson suggested that a motion to approve the engagement letter at hand, as executed in this case by Director Webking, would affirm the Boards approval of this years' auditor.

Director Webking made a motion to approve the Engagement Letter from Eide Bailly for an estimated \$15,450 – separate from travel expenses, as executed on February 11, 2020, for the fiscal year ending November 30, 2020. Director Humphrey seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Loyd will additionally execute the original engagement letter affirming approval for the Districts' files.

PREVENTATIVE MAINTENANCE

General Manager McMahon spoke to the series of items reflected as planned preventative maintenance repairs for Spring work:

Cla-Yal's – this year, as part of the regular rotation for these repairs, many of these are on the schedule for repair. This is simply routine, but critically important – preventative work.

St. Lukes lift station is at its twenty year life and so scheduled repairs are planned, via an entity out of Salt Lake. Detail reflected addresses some material costs.

Repairs for a few of the wells has also been included – repairs are based on use hours and accordingly this work will be conducted in both Spring and Fall of 2020.

Meter replacement information is a follow up to earlier conversation. Meters were originally installed starting in 1998, with a ten year life. As these age, they do not read as accurately, which impacts the revenue for the District.

Roofing repair has been an issue for several years, and is planned finally for Spring 2020.

The truck purchases are specific to the aging of the existing District vehicles, and dovetailing the insurance settlement for the totaled GMC, coupled with trading in the two existing used vehicles.

Director Webking asked about the totaled GMC, with specific reference to SVWSD liability. General Manager McMahon confirmed that there is no pending liability, and he is also okay.

All of these have been approved, and the particular maker of District truck(s) for replacement has been left to the discretion of the Operations Team. Director Webking referenced the budget line item total of \$263,000 and that the rough total of \$220,000 estimated above. Director Webking referenced that not much room was left for the rest of the fiscal year with a view to the budget. Chairman Loyd confirmed that the District operations are not an exact science. Director Lake inquired about how vehicle purchase occurred, the bidding process for such purchase – and discussion of the lengthy auction process for government vehicles. General Manager McMahon inquired about the usefulness of a motion or simply discussion, in referenced to Board intent and 2019 resolution. Attorney Robertson confirmed a motion would be appropriate.

Director Humphrey motioned to approve the purchase of two (2) replacement work vehicles, including the trade in of the existing trucks as well as a proposal not to replace the third vehicle and to apply that insurance payment against the purchase of new trucks.

Director Brown seconded and the motion passed unanimously.

Chairman Loyd inquired about the photo of the couch at the Sage Booster Station. This is an abandoned couch which incurred minor expense for disposal costs at Ohio Gulch, separate from trespass issues. Reference about access to that station by locals, other utility vendors, etc. and pending new development also occurred.

DISTRICT 37

General Manager McMahon spoke to the most recent Water District 37 meeting. Northside Canal Company has a 15CFS water right, and does not want to fund cloud seeding assessed expense based on that right. Reference to the perceived success of cloudseeding for this winter season was expressed. General Manager McMahon, as Chair of that District, has a meeting on Thursday to continue this conversation on participation commitments and shared benefits. The audit for the District was included, Ware & Associates having conducted that audit and financial statement process. Discussion of cost for such review, in relation to the Sun Valley Districts' audit, occurred.

GALENA WATER DISTRICT

General Manager McMahon spoke to the most recent Galena Water District meeting. This District continues to work on a groundwater drafted management plan (roughly the fifth iteration), and the Northside Canal Company factors in this drafted plan related to committed actions (providing water) to satisfy the callers, in an event. Kristy Molyneux, Brockway Engineering, Dave Shaw have all taken the draft of this document in hand. The drafted document, designed to mitigate the immediate impacts of a 'call' on the local areas, seems to be fairly close to ready to present to the IDWR Directors.

WELL 13 & BENEFICIAL USE

Attorney Robertson spoke to the confirmed approval of Well 13. IDWR has reviewed the Water Master Plan Report, and approved the Well accordingly. At the time, IDWR spoke to the Water Master Plan being an acceptable tool for the planned application for Well 14, however, recent conversation suggests that there might be additional supporting documentation required.

Director Webking expressed thanks to Pat for the breadth of information provided for the Board to review.

OTHER BUSINESS

The drafted Spring 2020 quarterly billing insert information is useful. Crawl space drainage into the sewer lines will be an item of focus in the coming weeks. Director Webking suggested the inclusion of a date on the insert. Some discussion of how many homes had crawl space pumping issues. General Manager McMahon estimated 50% of homes which require crawl space drainage were using the sewer lines for crawlspace drainage, an action which unnecessarily burdens the Ketchum Sewer Treatment Plant facility.

The most recent update of the Idaho Open Meeting Law, as prepared by the Attorney General, was reviewed briefly. Posting notice / clarification confirmed that the website holds notice information as well as the City of Sun Valley's locations and posted Agenda actions of communication taken by the District Staff. Attorney Robertson confirmed that there are no issues or concerns for the Sun Valley Water & Sewer District related to this legal guideline.

Attorney Robertson discussed the legal information included in the Board packet, related to the Pocatello suit of water rights. Attorney Robertson noted that he and General Manager McMahon have been in considered review of the merits of unifying the SVWSD rights, the purpose of which is to be equipped to pump the full scope of the water rights within the wells in total, rather than per location. Reference to lenient experience during the adjudication process, and hopes for same going forward. In short, if one well were to reduce or cease function source – could the volume of the right be drawn from a neighboring well or wells within the District larger water right system. This flexibility would be a heavily useful service and support to the members (current and future) of the Sun Valley Water & Sewer District. Transfers of water rights are an issue, as the State looks to see the impacts of the draw from neighboring wells. In the Pocatello case, the Supreme Court allowed for, but put some restrictions on the transfer process – if the new point of diversion does not interfere with other rights (with given dates). This assessment process of quantifying source and volume as well as determining negative impact is at this time very difficult to quantify.

Director Webking inquired about Well 14 (as currently planned) being included as part of the possible submittal in this overlay / transfer process, and Attorney Robertson suggested that, in a first things first basis – that the District is best served by proving up on Well 14 separately. Once this right has been established, then additional points of diversion could be then pursued. Otherwise, the inclusion of the as-yet-unapproved well 14 might suggest lack of demonstrable need based on the theory of the new well.

Snowpack Trackers,

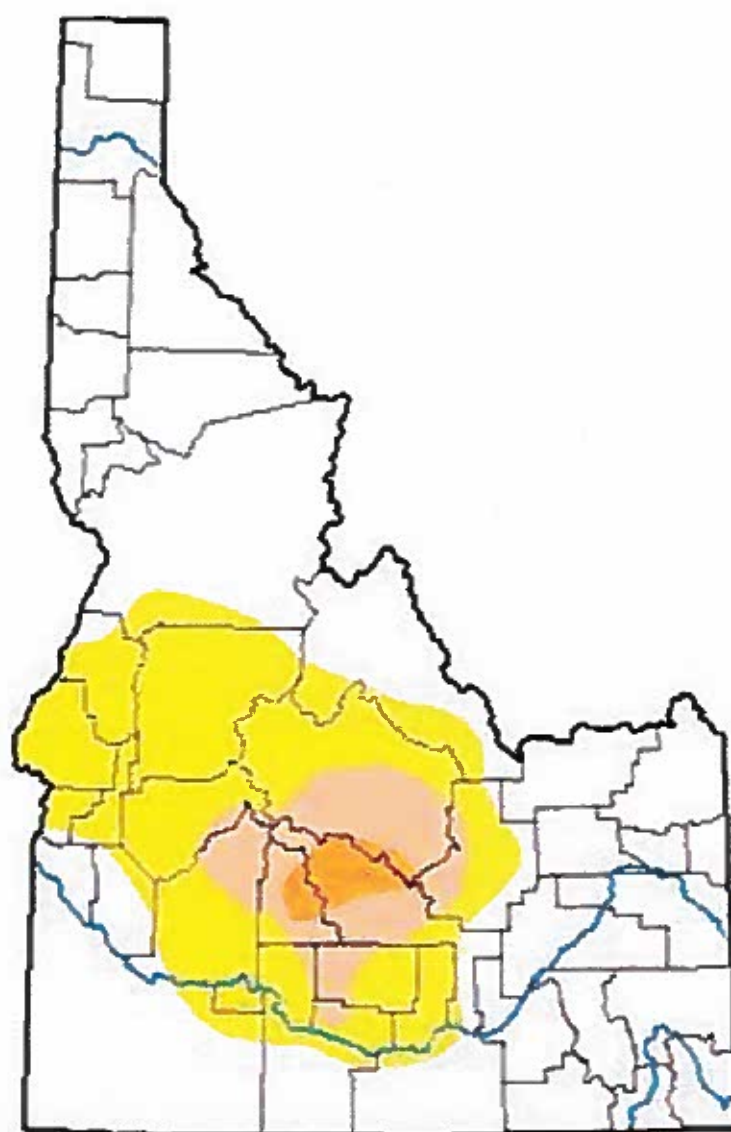
Since last week we have seen the median SWE decline by -3%. This dry trend is likely to continue for another week. Currently the statewide average basin condition for median snowpack is 95%. Currently the average stateside basin condition is 85% of annual peak snowpack.

However, snowpack conditions in the Big Wood, Little Wood, and Big Lost River basins are quickly approaching records lows for the season. The snow is especially low in the Pioneer Mountains, Boulder, and Smoky Mountains. SWE at Chocolate Gulch Snotel station north of Ketchum is the second lowest on record for this time of year. SWE at the Lost-Wood Divide, Hyndman, and Swede Peak Snotel stations have set record lows for this time of year. All three of these Snotel sites have been operated for 39 to 40 years. From a snowpack perspective both the Little Wood and Big Lost Basins are categorized as being in *extreme* drought with the Big Wood only slightly better, being categorized as *severe*.







The overall drought condition of this region was degraded to *severe* by the United States Drought Monitor last Thursday.
